The truss rod is installed into Stinger guitars and basses from the top of the neck, giving you a true neck of a single piece of rock maple. Stinger guitars and basses feature an ash body for bright tone with excellent sustain.

SOLID BRASS BRIDGE

The Stinger feature solid brass bridge for optimum sustain and individual brass saddles of long travel and height adjust for accurate intonation and good string action.

PHASE SWITCH

The Stinger guitars feature a mini toggle switch to allow you to throw the middle pickup (of 2095) out of phase with either the bridge or fingerboard pickups, and to throw two pickups (of 2095) out of phase.
