

Introduction

After 25 years retrospective? Muir of Ordance has actually been making electric guitars for over 40 years now. However, we feel it was the establishment of the House office in Philadelphia 25 years ago that best marks the beginning of the "new" classic company that most of us are familiar with.

During those 25 years Boenitz has built the "Classic Alternative" guitar company, a provider of innovative, well made guitars and basses that caters players a good alternative to "The Big Two". In addition, conservative models and M-style series might be contrasted with just two or three guitar designs and a couple of bass models (yes, we claim it's an old claim) and done up in various of these designs, Boenitz has concentrated on instruments for players who were looking for something different. Instruments like the Artist guitars, the Icarus, the George Brown's IBM, the RE, the S-Soundgarden basses, and more recently the concert wiring ATA guitars and the Peter Murphy's Islands.

Many of these Boenitz instruments are now sought after equipment for the working player as well as classic and collected items in their own right. Oh yeah, the last 25 years have seen a few extremely oddball Boenitz designs that probably won't ever be collector's items (although considering what goes in and out of fashion in guitar collecting, you never know). But a tiny "flea-chromosome" are all sort of anything used to get some-thing started.

Besides simply showing our 1997 line of guitars, basses, and effects, you'll notice that the pages of this catalog are underscored by a time-line that helps us look back at what one's been up to for the last 25 years, not only at Boenitz, but in music, in general.

And while it's important look back from time to time, instruments like our new Equinox basses obviously are still looking to the future of basses and guitars. Whether your preferences in instruments are futuristic, contemporary, or downright old fashioned, we believe you'll find a *Classic Alternative* in the pages of this catalog, a guitar or bass that will meet your very individual needs.

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George Benson models



The GB10 is one of the most successful designs of the last 20 years. Introduced in 1972, the GB10 was designed in collaboration with jazz guitarist George Benson who wanted a smaller bodied instrument that could be played standing up or sitting down and wouldn't feedback like mid-sized jazz guitars during high-volume performances. Lots of other guitarists must have been looking for the same thing as the GB10 has been "hotter" longer running signature model.

For 1973, Benson finally debuts the GB10S Jazz Standard, a truly affordable George Benson model that offers the mid-size (GB10) features of a small body fitted with feedback-resistant floating-microhumidifiers, a rosewood bridge and 22-fret neck. The differences are the GB10S's wider top and its more underscored bending and pickguard. Now, owning a George Benson guitar is a treat!

Pat Metheny models



Rarely considered a legend, Pat Metheny continues to break ground in the realm of guitar playing. From his innovative leapfrogging with the Pat Metheny Group to his trademark sound collection with Dennis Lehane on Song II, his genre-shattering performance on *Dave Tolenca the Silence*, Metheny has always reinvented several steps ahead of the pack.

Pat Metheny's relationship with Boenzer goes all the way back to 1980, when he chose a PM100 for his first solid guitar; the PM100, an era introduction. New for 1997, the PM20 is a more traditional design. This stellar sounding jazz instrument is a surprisingly accurate version of Pat's original single cutaway Boenzer guitar that he has played for over fifteen years.


